If you have a child, or you know of someone who has a child, who will be ready to start school in 2025, please contact us for more information regarding this exciting initiative.



If your child is absent from school for 3 days and we have not received an explanation, we will contact you to follow this up, as is the Department regulation.

School Fees 2024

In consultation with the P&C, school fees have been set for the year and a statement has been sent home. Your statement is also available on the School Bytes app.

This year we have simplified the school contribution you pay. There is now just the one fee, which is then 50% less for the second child and 75% less for the third child.

The fee is a little more than previous years as there has been no increase for many years. This has been approved by the P&C.

All school contributions charged in NSW government schools are voluntary.

However, our school is small, as is our budget, so your contribution enhances the resources we can make available to our students.

Your contribution covers all consumables such as pencils, markers, paper, craft and art supplies, glue etc.

We also try to cover any local excursions so that your family is not continually asked to pay for things. The 3-6 camp, however, will always be charged to you.

Thank you for paying your school fees if you are able to.

It is easy to pay online through your School Bytes Parent Portal. If you haven't as yet downloaded the app, please do so.

We can also accept cash at the office but the above method is preferred by the Education Dept.
