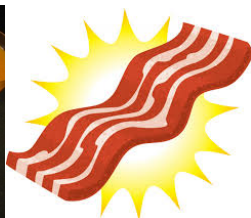
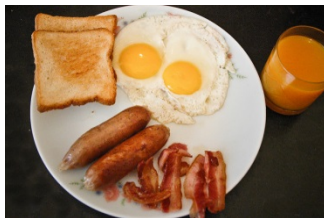
BACON AND EGG DAY
