 **The simplest way**

... To make Japanese veggie pancakes

Makes: 12 | Prep time: 15 min | Cook time: 10 min

Ingredients

- 1/2 small cabbage, very thinly sliced
- 4 medium carrots, grated
- 2 cups baby spinach, thinly sliced
- 4 spring onions, thinly sliced
- 1/2 cup wholemeal plain flour
- 6 large eggs, lightly beaten
- Pinch of salt
- Olive oil spray

Method

Place the vegies in a bowl and mix together. Toss with the flour, coating all the vegies. Stir in the eggs and pinch of salt. Lightly spray a large non-stick fry pan with olive oil spray and heat over med-high heat. You may need to re-spray between batches. Add heaped tablespoons of the mixture to the fry pan in rounds. 
