National Parks doing big things for our small school.

On behalf of Milbrodale Public School, we would like to express our sincere thanks to the National Parks Office in Bulga. Going back a few years, the National Parks office has been donating their recycling cans and bottles to Milbrodale Public School to help us raise much needed funds for our students. Recently, we took everything they had down to Newcastle and to our amazement we raised \$252.80. A substantial amount that will help the P&C support the school in projects that will directly benefit the students. It is no small donation, especially since they do it each year and we benefit greatly from it. From our students and community, we would all like to thank them for everything they do for our students.

Malabar Resources visiting our Assembly

This Thursday, Malabar energy will be visiting our school to present us with four iPads as a donation and recognition of our growth over the past year. As we attract more students we need more resources and Malabar have come to the rescue donating \$3,800 worth of iPads to the school for use in the Kindergarten to Year 2 classroom.

Glencore, the Cubby Houses and Covered Walkways

Over the past two years, Glencore have consistently donated \$14,000 each year for projects to support our school. Two years ago it was to build the covered walkway between the classroom and the eating area. Last year it was for the purchase of cubbyhouses as outdoor learning areas and play equipment for our students. On Wednesday 10 April, we will be unveiling our new cubbyhouses for the students to play in.

The day before (Tuesday 9 April) we will be inviting all parents to come to the school between 1:30-2:00pm for a free sausage sizzle right before our end of term assembly 2-3pm during which time we will be unveiling the cubbyhouses with our Glencore friends. The students will then be allowed to play on them for a little while for promotional photo purposes.

All Absences must be explained

Please let us know about any planned or unexpected absences before or straight after the day it occurs. It can be easily forgotten.

You can send your explanation easily through the School Bytes app, or you can send an email, or give us a call.

If your child is absent from school for 3 days and we have not received an explanation, we will contact you to follow this up, as is the Department regulation.

School Fees 2024

In consultation with the P&C, school fees have been set for the year and a statement has been sent home. Your statement is also available on the School Bytes app.

This year we have simplified the school contribution you pay. There is now just the one fee, which is then 50% less for the second child and 75% less for the third child.

The fee is a little more than previous years as there has been no increase for many years. This has been approved by the P&C.

All school contributions charged in NSW government schools are voluntary.

However, our school is small, as is our budget, so your contribution enhances the resources we can make available to our students.

Your contribution covers all consumables such as pencils, markers, paper, craft and art supplies, glue etc.

We also try to cover any local excursions so that your family is not continually asked to pay for things. The 3-6 camp, however, will always be charged to you.

Thank you for paying your school fees if you are able to.

It is easy to pay online through your School Bytes Parent Portal. If you haven't as yet downloaded the app, please do so.

We can also accept cash at the office but the above method is preferred by the Education Dept.

Carers Group. This is a private group for our families only.


